<p><b>Other Things to Pack</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Sleeping bag and fitted single sheet</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Pillow and pillowcase</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> 1 Towel</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Toilet bag, toothbrush, toothpaste, brush or comb, soap, face washer</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Tissues or handkerchief</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Plastic bag for dirty clothing</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Torch (optional)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> 1 small drink bottle (named)</li> </ul>	<p><b>Medication</b></p> <p>Any medication required must be in a bag and clearly labelled with the child's name and dosage clearly documented on the Medical Report Form</p> <p><b>Camera/Games</b></p> <p><b>No electronic games or walkmans.</b> Cameras will be the children's own responsibility. Film should be brought from home (and loaded in the camera). There will be no opportunity to purchase film at the camp.</p>
<p><b>Food and Snacks</b></p> <p><b>No food or snacks are to be brought to the camp.</b> The camp will provide more than enough food to enable the children to complete all activities, without the need for snacks brought from home.</p>	<p><b>Money</b></p> <p>Children should not bring any money to camp. We will not be visiting shops, so there will not be any opportunity to spend it.</p>
