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Bike Education Program Grade 5&6 2017

Dear Parents,

In Term 4 students in grade 5 & 6 will be involved in the Bike Education Program. Bike Ed is an important component of the school's Outdoor Education Program and is part of the Health and Physical Education area.

The program organized for our grade 5s aims to assist the students to become safe and competent cyclists while riding on footpaths. The focus for grade 6 students will be educating students about the road rules and becoming safe and competent cyclist while on the road. Both grades will be supervised by Bike Ed Certified instructors with an aim of attaining their Level Two Bike Ed Pathway Cycling Certificate (grade 5) and Level 3 Bike Ed ON-Road Cycling Certificate (grade 6).

The grade 5/6 Bike Ed Program will run on the following dates:

- Monday 4th December
- Wednesday 6th December
- Friday 8th December
- Monday 11th December
- Wednesday 13th December
- Friday 15th December



The first component of the Bike Ed program will be **the helmet and bike check** (this needs to be completed at home). All students will need a bike and an approved helmet in a serviceable condition to take part in the Bike Ed Program. Please check your child's bike and helmet using the information attached. A final check will be conducted at school on **Tuesday 31st, Thursday 2nd and Friday 3rd of November**. Any faults and repairs indicated on the report need to be addressed before the riding skills component begins on the **28th of November**.
