RECYCLING - SUSTAINABILITY

At Carrum Primary School we are proud of being a sustainable school and being able to recycle items to keep them out of landfill. We also enjoy helping the wider community collect recycled items for organisations to use to benefit others.

Thank you to everyone who has supported our bottle top collection for Envision so far. We made our first drop off last week and will continue to collect bottle top lids this term, so please keep bringing in your clean bottle tops.

This term we will also be collecting bread tags for 'Breadtags for wheelchairs' and oral care products for TerraCycle.


The Breadtag for wheelchairs project collects breadtags which are sold to recycling companies and the proceeds are used to purchase wheelchairs for people who need them. 200 kgs tags = 1 wheelchair. Check out their facebook page www.facebook.com/breadtagsforwheelchairs/ for more information.

TerraCycle have partnered with Colgate to create a free recycling program for oral care product packaging. The program accepts waste: TOOTHBRUSH TUBES and caps, toothbrushes, toothpaste cartons, toothbrush outer packaging, and floss containers. Please note electric toothbrushes or battery toothbrushes are not recyclable through the program. Please ensure all excess product has been removed (i.e. leftover toothpaste or floss). Once collected, the tubes and brushes are separated by composition, shredded and melted into hard plastic that can be remoulded to make new recycled products. EVERYONE WELCOME!


This group is for anyone who would like to get moving and meet other parents/carers/friends from Carrum Primary School.
