Some of the roles in Toastmasters include the three coordinators who run different parts of the show. **Sizzlers** is when four kids get up the front and they each have 30 seconds to continue on a story that the **topic creator** gives to the group. There are two groups of Sizzlers. We also have two **Presenters** who showcase a 2 minute presentation on a topic of their choice. We have two **Presenter Evaluators** who give feedback to the presenter letting them know what they did well and what they could improve on. The program also includes a **Time Keeper** who lets everyone know how long they have spoken for and a **Gruntmaster** who lets everyone know how many times they've said "umm" and "arr", because great public speakers don't say "umm" and "arr". There are also **Harkmasters** who ask everyone questions about the Presenters presentation.



Last but not least we have **Whiz Bang**. Whiz Bang is where six kids stand up in front of everyone and the **topic creator** gives a topic and one at a time each kid says two words to keep the story going. There are also **Whiz Bang scribes** who scribe whatever the Whiz Bang group says. **We love Toasties!!**
