Goal 1	Build practice excellence to support student learning growth with a particular focus on Numeracy and Literacy across all disciplines and year levels.
Target 1.1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Achieve consistent growth of 12 months or more across all areas of teacher judgements against the curriculum frameworks. • Achieve a reduction in the gap between teacher judgement data and Australian normed assessments (e.g. PATM, PATR, NAPLAN, TORCH).
